

The Spirit Nature of Our Potential:

Jeremiah 29:11 — For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.

Ephesians 2:10 — For we are God’s workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God prepared in advance for us to do.

John 10:10 — The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I (Jesus) have come that they may have life and have it to the full.
